## KIM VERSLOOT

I asked my kids to describe me, they said: home grown (I've lived in Slave Lake and area more years than not, since 1970), forest dweller, spiritual seeker, and family and dog lover. In addition to these most important descriptors, I also love the work that I do and am grateful to have found my calling early in life.

A personal loss when I was 15, led me on the path to becoming a psychologist. I began with Alberta Mental Health and Addictions and then decided to open my private practice in 2000 here in Slave Lake. I specialize in mindful somatic psychotherapy, developmental psychology, clinical psychology, grief and loss, and the resolution of trauma.

Mindful somatic psychotherapy or Hakomi for me was the collision of spirituality and psychology, a therapy method and process to help myself and others heal. I was initially drawn to its guiding principles and after four years of training and supervised practice became a Certified Hakomi Therapist (2006); this process led me to the contemplative practices of mindfulness and meditation. Mindfulness has become a way of life; I meditate frequently and lead a regular bimonthly meditation group. I am kind and compassionate, have a calling to help, and long for all of us to live fulfilling lives in a peaceful world.

## TRADITIONAL RATTLE MAKING

Pauline will be sharing learned knowledge about rawhide rattles as historically used by Indigenous people in the area. Protocol will be followed in making of the rattle and respectful practices and care.

Project will take approximately 5 hrs over 2 days. 3 hrs to thread the rawhide and shape the rattle, fill with sand and let rawhide dry overnight. 24 hrs later, empty the sand, prepare your handle, add pebbles into the rawhide, insert the handle and wrap the sinew to secure handle and then decorate your rattle.


